## Detecting Marred Porcelain with Blacklight

Cracks and repairs in fine porcelain art objects can no longer be successfully concealed. Blak-Ray® longwave ultraviolet lamps aid the antique collector in acquiring only those pieces that are not marred by cracks and breaks. When viewed under blacklight, hard-to-see cracks will fluoresce brightly. Hidden repairs are also easily detected since most adhesives are clearly visible under blacklight.
